E-Consultations:

If you are struggling to get through to your practice, E-Consultations are also offered at practices (Please check your surgery's website) Follow the instructions as advised and submit your symptoms. Once completed, this is then triaged and allocated either a telephone or a face to face appointment. At times you may only receive guidance back from your surgery depending on the condition

Diagnostic Spirometry Hub:

All practices can now refer into a newly established diagnostic spirometry hub. At present, appointments are only available at Riverview and Houghton.

Over the counter medicine:

Patients are encouraged to buy medication that is available to buy over the counter for ailments that can be self-managed e.g. Paracetamol, Ear and Eye products, Emollients for dry skin etc.
