F.A.C.T Fighting All Cancers Together	A presentation was delivered to the Group by Anjali Brough from F.A.C.T.  Anjali gave an overview of the background of the setup of the Charity.  An overview of FACT Services offering to benefit cancer patients and support their family, friends and carers. NO referral is necessary and you do not have to be a patient to benefit from their sessions.  Discussion took place regarding the Wig Service, Mastectomy Wear/Bra Fitting Services, and Counselling Services.  FACT also have hub sites where these services take place in Sunderland, Newcastle, Northumberland, North Tyneside and Durham and a site at Houghton will be opening soon.  NEAREST SITE TO PRACTICES: Sunderland, 35 Blandford Street, Sunderland, SR1 3JH.  JT queries whether the leaflets are in electronic format which will enable to practice to add to their TV Screens. NHS App	JT gave an overview of the new NHS App that will be available in the Sunderland Area. The NHS App will allow you to access appointments, medication, allergies and also access to your full medical record through the app. JT explained the registration process to members. Very limited information at present, as soon as the practice receives a "go live" date then we will share this.	
Results of Access Survey	JT shared results of recent Access Survey. 927 patients have completed this survey. The results were very pleasing and overall satisfaction with the access we offer.	
	IVR Appointment Booking seems to be the most popular method of booking appointments. We have now increased our online appointments and now offer 25% of appointments across all disciplines.	
Annual Statistics 2018/2019	JT shared an overview of the headline statistics for 2018/2019 in order that PPG members can understand what activity goes on in the background of General Practice. This is only a snapshot.	
	ALMc – asked about the process for signing of EPS prescriptions. JT explained this is not a physical electronic signature this is all done through a GP smartcard and a unique PIN is used by the GP which then signs these prescriptions electronically.	
	ALMc – Childhood Immunisations. Practice has achieved 98% uptake for their childhood immunisations which is a good achievement. JT reported that we continue to have issues with DNA's for Childhood Imms however we have a robust internal process whereby after 3 DNA's we notify the Health Visitor who then contacts the family. We also report this to our Safeguarding Lead.	
PPC Mosting	Discussion took place regarding the uptake of MMR vaccinations. JT reported that some parents do opt out of MMR vaccinations, however this is a	Page 2 of 5

	parental choice and unfortunately we are unable to force people to have vaccinations they choose not to.	
	It was noted that the Practice participates in all the National vaccinations programmes.	
	HPV vaccination from this year will also be offered to boys for the first time.
