### 2. Health and Wellbeing Coach Update

Michelle gave an overview or service

The Surgery now has a Health and Wellbeing coach as part of the PCN. Her name is Michelle, and she can help with various issues affecting your lifestyle such as diet, exercise, issues around diabetes and pre-diabetes, weight loss, menopause and mobility. You can either be referred once your seen a clinician or you can self-refer.

Michelle will contact you shortly after that.

We are shortly commencing with a 12 week pre-diabetes program where we are targeting those patients who have had a diagnosis of pre-diabetes across the PCN and offering group sessions to help them gain a better understanding of their diagnosis and what they can do to decrease their chances of developing diabetes.

We have arranged for the patients for the initial group to attend already but we will run programs one after another throughout the year.

#### 3. <u>Dr Jaiveloo – Update of Building extension</u>

Dr Jaiveloo gave a brief update the building extension plans and should the group a diagram of the plans. He explained that he is currently gaining quotes, and then we will be applying for help with funding from the Integrated Care Board.

## 4. Update on GP's

Sue explained that since Dr Jaiveloo has returned the surgery has retained some of the locums that covered whilst Dr Jaiveloo had been on sick leave.

We now have an extra GP each day of the week, so more access for patients that ever before. We now have, Dr Vakkund, Dr Obesaki, Dr Sivarajan, Dr Thoufeeq, Dr Humble and a new gp starting next week Dr Gopal.

Hoping that once we have enough room that the Nurse Practitioner will work full time, which will also provide more capacity.

#### 5. List Closure update

Sue explained that a further closure extension was now in place, and this was to continue until the 17<sup>th</sup> October, after that we will re-open and begin to take new patients again.
