Here are some this month's suggestions and responses.

Suggestion: Could we have magazines, toys, and a coffee/food vending machine?

Response: Due to infection control, we were required to remove everything from the surgery including magazines and children's toys. We are not like A & E and do not offer a walk-in service where you may be in the department for several hours, so we that a coffee/food vending machine would not be suitable. We also do not have the space.

Suggestion: Why do you have a radio at Settle, but not at Hellifield?

Response: This is something that we hadn't thought of, but we can look into putting a radio in down at our Hellifield Surgery.

Suggestion: Please can you play a radio channel other than classical music.

Response: We were playing classical music at the surgery for a while and some patient feedback was positive. Obviously, we are not going to suit all tastes in music. We are

currently playing smooth radio, which plays varied easy listening music.

Suggestion: When are the Doctors going to start doing surgeries at Hellifield?

Response: The doctors are back working from Hellifield, doing a couple of surgeries a week, along with a full selection of nurse appointments. Most of our appointments are at our main site in Settle. But please ask the receptionist what they can offer you at Hellifield surgery.
