CDCs work in harmony with other NHS healthcare services. Results from tests conducted at CDCs are seamlessly shared with primary care providers and hospital specialists, ensuring continuity of care.

Available Services at Askham Bar's Community Diagnostic Centre provided by Nimbuscare

The services at Askham Bar's CDC are provided by the York & Scarborough Teaching Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust, and Nimbuscare.

The available services provided by Nimbuscare are:

- **Phlebotomy (Blood testing)**
- **12 lead ECG (Assessment of heart's electrical activity)**
- **Ambulatory Blood Pressure Monitoring**
- **Spirometry (Breathing test)**
- **FeNO- Fractional Exhaled Nitric Oxide (Breath test for lung inflammation)**
