Welcome To Station Road Surgery

We are a training practice, and you may be offered an appointment with a GP registrar. A GP registrar is a fully qualified doctor who is gaining experience in General Practice before looking for a practice of their own.

New Patients

We welcome new patients who live within our practice area, a copy of which is available from our receptionists and on our website. All new patients are asked to complete a registration form and health questionnaires prior to registration. Patients on repeat medication must see a doctor before getting their first prescription. Please bring your repeat medication list to this appointment. All new patients are invited to attend for a new patient health check.

Making An Appointment

We offer a triage system via e-consult, these can be completed from 7.00am to 5pm Mon-Fri. All e-consults will be triaged by the Duty Doctor and a member of the reception team will be in touch with in 72 hours. This service should not be used for urgent medical attention.

Extended Access

We offer evening appointments on Mondays, these are pre booked appointments only between 18.30 and 20.00. We also do 1 in 4 Saturdays 9.00am to 17.00

Cervical Smears

Female patients aged between 24 years, 6 months - 65 years and meeting certain criteria will be invited to have a cervical smear by West Yorkshire Central Services.

Holiday Vaccinations

These are organised by the practice nurse. Most vaccines are now available from the practice, but you may need a prescription. Please allow plenty of time to have your vaccinations before travelling. You need to fill in a travel form first, you can find this on our website or collect one from surgery.

Minor Surgery

We offer a range of minor surgical procedures to treat minor lumps and bumps. Please see your doctor who will be able to assess your suitability for these treatments.

Social Prescriber

We have a social prescriber who works at our surgery every day. Our social prescriber is a signposting service, below are a few things she can help you with. You can self-refer by asking the receptionist to add you to the waiting list.
