## Long Covid support

Most infections with Covid resolve within four weeks but sometimes symptoms can be on-going. If you're concerned about any of your symptoms and it's been four weeks or more since you became unwell with Covid, please contact us and we will book you in for a consultation with one of our GPs who can then assess you and provide access to further assessments or support you might need.

### Cancer Screening

The NHS has prioritised cancer throughout the pandemic, reflected by the fact that treatment levels have been back at 100% since this time last year and referral levels have been at record highs.

One of our Patient Participation Group members, Harry Shields, experienced this first-hand when he was diagnosed with liver cancer last year. For the past three years, Harry has been taking part in a clinical trial (called iBEAT) and part of the research involved having an MRI scan; it was following this scan that liver cancer was first suspected.

Once the diagnosis had been confirmed by the team at Leeds, radiotherapy was used to treat Harry's cancer — which he received throughout September last year — and the good news is Harry responded so well to treatment and has made such a great recovery that he is now busy planning a holiday to Spain.

National awareness campaigns continue to focus on the benefits of early screening and how it can help stop cancer before it starts, which is why the NHS has been urging people not to ignore screening invitations.



Unlike some cancers with clear symptoms, prostate cancer is a bit more complicated because it doesn't cause symptoms at an early stage. For this reason, Prostate Cancer UK has designed a 30 second risk checker to help men understand their risk of prostate cancer and to then make an informed choice about the PSA

test. (prostatecanceruk.org/risk-checker).
