APPOINTMENTS

Same day appointments

Please ring the surgery at 8am to book on the day.

Urgent appointments

Once the same day appointments are full, we triage all urgent requests. A GP will assess patients by telephone and those in that need to be seen face to face.

Advanced appointments

These are normally 2-3 weeks in advance and can be a phone or face to face appointment. These can be booked by telephone, in person or online.

Home Visits

Visits can be arranged for housebound or extremely ill patients. For an urgent home visit, please call the surgery and the team will organise this with the doctors.

E-Consultations

We have now launched a new e-consultation service which can be found on our website. You can check on referrals, request sick notes and medication, request appointments without having to wait on the phone!

PRESCRIPTIONS

New patients who are on regular medication will need to book an appointment once registered.

In person

Request slips are available to fill in at reception by the prescription post box.

You can post your prescription slip or written request to us at the practice.

Phone

We accept requests via telephone; however, we ask that if you can order by the other ways, please do so. This ensures the patients who need to request by phone, such as the elderly and housebound, will be able to do so easily and quickly.
