Water Safety this summer.

Being by water is a great place to spend time with friends, but it's important you know how to keep yourself, and your friends, safe.

There were 277 accidental drownings in the UK in 2021. 62% of these happened at inland waters and 83% of these were male.

No matter how strong a swimmer you are, you can't prepare for cold water shock. Even on an extremely hot day, open water can be incredibly cold.



First Contact Physiotherapy(FCP)

A FCP is an advanced practitioner working within primary care with extensive expertise in clinical assessment, diagnosis and management of musculoskeletal (MSK) conditions. FCP see patients with (suspected or diagnosed) MSK conditions as the first point of contact instead of seeing a GP first. They can refer your for further treatment and order investigations in exactly the same was as GP's.

To book an appointment, please contact your GP Reception Team and ask to book an appointment with the PCN First Contact Physiotherapist. Please note that Children under 16 cannot see the FCP.

NHS App Repeat Prescriptions

Did you know you can manage repeat prescriptions from Gibson Lane Practice in the NHS App?

You can easily choose where your prescriptions are sent. If you know you'll be away from home or you are moving home, you can change your nominated pharmacy from within the app.

You can also order your prescription at any time that suits you. There's no need to wait to join a telephone queue or wait until the GP surgery opens.

It's easy to use, and, if you hit a snag, you can go to 'Help' in the top right-hand corner of the app or visit nhs.uk/helpmeapp.
