Minutes of last Meeting

PCN Presentation

There are 30 PCN employees working across 6 GP practices in the Morley area – offering the following services:

People living with long-term conditions e.g., diabetes, blood pressure problems, mental health and heart conditions.

- · Look to work proactively.
- Can provide personal care.
- PCN's are led by Clinical Directors
- Able to create PCN Team roles.

Pharmacy Team, structure med reviews supporting long term conditions.

- Medication queries
- Medicine optimisation
- Discharge letter/clinic letters

AC asked why there are issues getting certain medication.

SI – said he found the ordering of prescriptions and overall running of the surgery was a more proactive way than previous ways - finds it amazing! A good journey!

Nurse Associates

- Foundation to nursing
- Top up to be a nurse and support nurses.
- Support housebound care and long-term conditions support.

Occupational Therapist

- Help with washing, dressing, bathing.
- Reduce falls.
- Reduce hospital admissions.
- Mobility around the home
- Can organise the supply of aids needed.

Social Prescribers

- Help patients who need non-clinical interventions.
- Refer to community groups.
- · Give welfare advice.
- Offer social care support.

Health and Wellbeing Coaches

- Weight management
- Smoking cessation
- Increasing physical activity
- Reduce risks of long-term conditions e.g., high blood pressure, diabetes and prediabetes, high cholesterol, obesity
- Support patients in lifestyle change to improve health and wellbeing.
- One to one session held but looking at starting some group sessions.

Physio first

- Sano Physiotherapy
- NHS wanted all GP surgeries to have physio first by 2024.
- Appointments can be booked with physio for injuries such as back pain, neck pain, shoulder pain, and forms of sports injuries.

JB asked how people find out about these services.

KR explained about our practice leaflet, this can be viewed on our website link <u>PCN - GP Services - Fountain Medical Centre</u>. The telephone message advises patients that the Care Navigation Team will ask questions in order to signpost to the appropriate service.

Extended Access

Offers GP and HCA appointments out of hours, evenings, and weekends. Clinics are run at Windsor House for the whole of Morley; supporting patients to access services at a time convenient to their needs.

Care Homes

- MDT looking after care homes residents across Morley.
- Support with long-term conditions
- Advance planning
- Palliative care
- On call service during practice hours
- Integrated with Neighbourhood Team
- Clinical guidance from Consultant Geriatrician

Wraparound Care Model Housebound Patients

- Support housebound patients.
- Lead by a Nurse Associate who can then signpost to relevant service.

Barriers we face as a PCN.

Best way forward is for Care Navigation Teams to signpost.
