



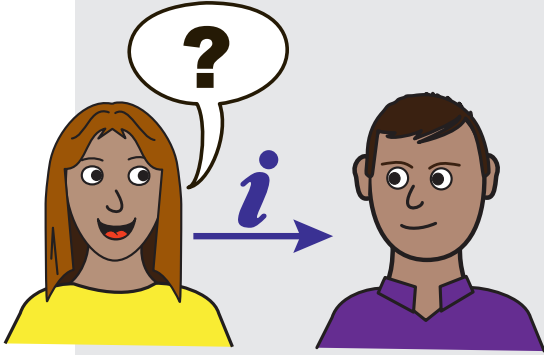

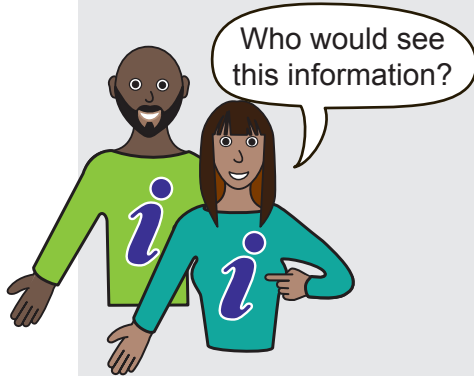


What is the Leeds Care Record?



It is a way of sharing important information about you with the people who care for you.

Nurse



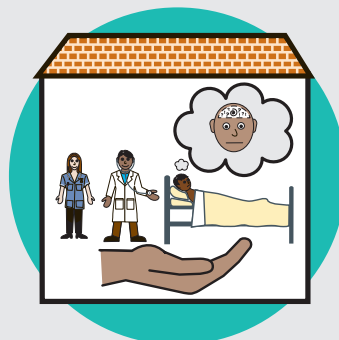
Hospital



Social Care Services



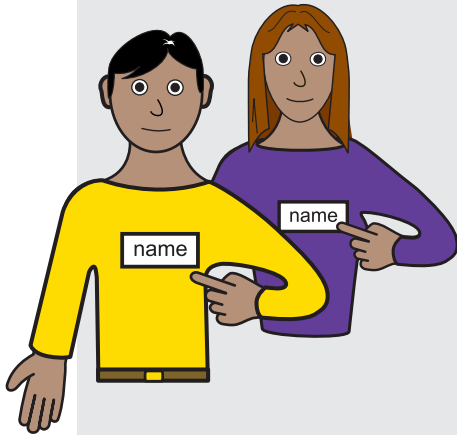
Mental Health Services

So how does it work?

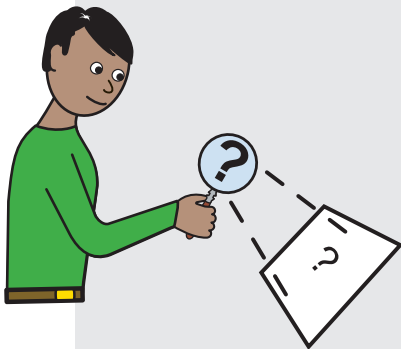


An example might be:
You are out and about in Leeds and become unwell.

You manage to get help and get to hospital but are too poorly to be able to tell the doctors and nurses everything they need to know.

By using your name they are able to find your Leeds Care Record.

Using your record they are able to



- Find out about your needs so they can give you the right care
- Make sure that other people know what has happened so they can help you get better

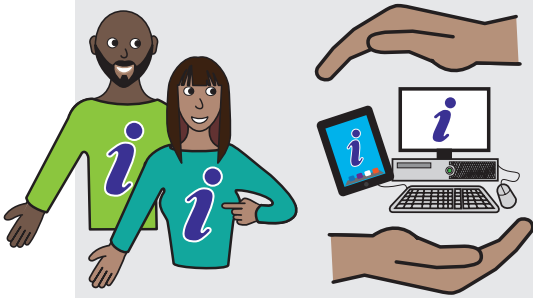
Why would I want to do this?



It can help:

- Make it easy for everyone to work together to get your care right
- To save time so that people can spend more time with you
- Less paperwork and forms to fill in
- You may not be asked the same questions again and again
- By keeping all your information safely in one place

Would anyone be able to see this information?

i Other people who care for you

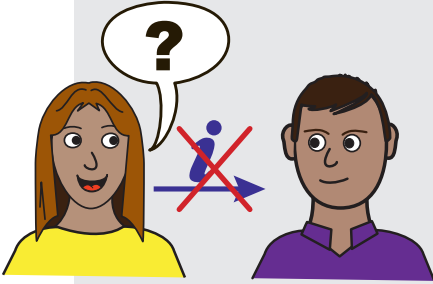
i Care plans

Information is kept in a private and safe system only the people involved in your care are able to see it.

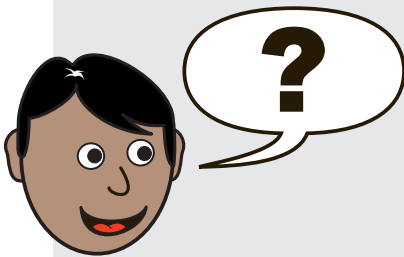
What if I don't want to?

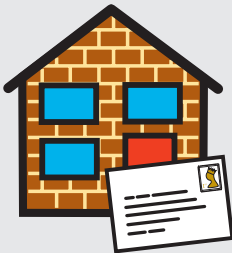
