## <u>NHS Health Check</u>

If you are aged 40 – 74 and do not suffer from heart disease, kidney disease, diabetes or had a stroke, you can have a free NHS health check. This is a simple, quick 30 minute screening appointment. Please ring our Patient Care Adviser team to see if you are eligible.

## DID NOT ATTEND

The practice continues to have a large number of patients who fail to attend their appointments. **Between January** - March 2018, 561 patients did not attend their appointments. This meant we lost 115 hours of clinical time. If you are unable to keep your appointment please let us know. Patients who fail to attend 3 appointments may be removed from our list. If you make an appointment, then do not need it, it is your responsibility to cancel it.

#### THE FUTURE OF ANTIBIOTICS IS IN OUR HANDS

Infections like coughs, colds, sore throats and flu should be treated without antibiotics – most of the time. The overuse of antibiotics means they are becoming less effective and has led to the emergence of "superbugs", strains of bacteria that have become resistant to some types of antibiotics. If you take antibiotics without consulting your doctor, you could be increasing the chance of them not working in the future.

#### **Pharmacy First**

The practice supports the Pharmacy First service. If you have a minor ailment such as a cough, cold, sore threadworms throat. or teething problems, your local pharmacy will be able to see you and offer treatment if appropriate. There are certain exclusions, but when you call the surgery you may be directed to Pharmacy First if appropriate.

#### **Repeat Medication**

If you take medication on a long-term basis, you can ask for a repeat prescription. The practice sends prescriptions electronically to local pharmacies.

#### **Repeat Medication requests can be made by:**

**Prescription counterfoil** with the items ticked or a **Letter** with your name, address, and date of birth: ensure the name, dose, strength and quantity of each drug is detailed. These can be put in the Post box in our reception area, posted, faxed (0113) 2777778 or e-mailed to *info.bvs@nhs.net* 

**Online via our Practice Website.** You will need to ask one of our Patient Care Advisers for a username and password for this service.

Your prescription will take two working days to process. Please ensure you leave enough time for the request before you run out of medication.
