FLU VACCINES

"I don't need a flu jab; I'm as fit as a flea". "I've never had a flu jab and I've never had the flu", "I knew someone who had a flu jab and got the flu". We hear these mythical tales from patients every year.

Your immunity wanes as you get older so even if you have never had a day's illness in your life, your chance of catching flu increases as time goes by. And people with chronic conditions (Asthma, diabetes, COPD, immune system deficiencies) are more likely to get flu.

The benefits outweigh the risks. The overwhelming evidence is that serious side effects are extremely rare. You are much less likely to get flu if you are immunised and flu can be fatal. "For many people it is an unpleasant illness but for the vulnerable in society...it is extremely dangerous and can be lethal" Professor Dame Sally Davies, the UK's Chief Medical officer of Health.

We urge all our patients who are more at risk to have the flu jab. Please contact the practice to arrange your appointment.
