



## Privacy Policy – EDSM SystmOne

<b>Plain English explanation</b>	
Enhanced Data Sharing Model enables clinician to get a full picture of all elements that affect your care and treatment. This will allow out of hours and other healthcare providers to access your records. Initial consent is provided for your information to be shared however you can explicitly consent for a share in and out of each organisation

<b>3) Purpose</b> of the processing	To provide you with the best possible care and support whilst using our services.
<b>4) Lawful basis</b> for processing	The processing of personal data in the delivery of direct care and for providers' administrative purposes in this surgery and in support of direct care elsewhere is supported under the following Article 6 and 9 conditions of the GDPR:  Article 6(1)(e) '...necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority...'.  Article 9(2)(h) 'necessary for the purposes of preventative or occupational medicine for the assessment of the working capacity of the employee, medical diagnosis, the provision of health or social care or treatment or the management of health or social care systems and services...'
<b>5) Recipient or categories of recipients</b> of the shared data	The data shared may be shared with local health and social care organisations using Systm1.
<b>6) Rights to object</b>	You have the right to object to some or all the information being processed under Article 21. Please contact the Data Controller. You should be aware that this is a right to raise an objection, that is not the same as having an absolute right to have your wishes granted in every circumstance.
<b>7) Right to access and correct</b>	<b>You have the right to access the data that is being shared and have any inaccuracies corrected. There is no right to have accurate medical records deleted except when ordered by a court of Law.</b>

<b>8) Retention period</b>	<b>The data will be retained in line with the law and national guidance.</b>
