Getting a prescription

All prescriptions are first issued by GPs or nurse prescribers after you are diagnosed at the practice. You can get the prescription in a number of ways:

- 1. By registering online at www.saffronhealth.co.uk/how-do-i-register-for-online-services/
- 2. By phoning **0116 216 0358** for our 24/7 automated appointment and repeat prescription service.
- 3. By ordering using the NHS App (www.nhs.uk/nhs-app/)
- 4. By using the Saffron Health reception number at 0116 244 0888 and pressing Option 1 between 10.30am and 3.30pm (This is also for a prescription query).
- By posting or taking your repeat prescription form to Saffron Health reception (this is the form you receive every time your drugs are dispensed by your chosen pharmacy).
