
Upcoming closed for training dates:

Telephone calls and appointments: We continue to offer 'on the day' telephone consultations with our: GP's / Advanced Nurse Practitioner / Paramedic (*clinicians will differ on the day due to shift patterns/annual leave*). We also have the support of our additional roles staff: Clinical Pharmacist / Pharmacy Technician / Physiotherapist / Mental Heath Practitioner / Social Prescribers / Health & Wellbeing Coach. Since changing our systems to a telephone triage system this has allowed us to increase our appointment capacity by over 25% in the past 12 months alone. We are offering more appointments now than ever before and are working harder than ever before.

In December our total inbound calls were: 12,384, November inbound calls were: 13,158 and October inbound calls were: 13,686. December '22 we had an audit completed on our appointments, below are these results:



Extended access: We are now able to book into out-of-hours hubs at The Centre Surgery in Hinckley and Newbold Verdon Practice. These appointments are available to book Monday-Friday 6:30pm-8pm and Saturdays 8am-5pm. These can be for GP/ANP appointments, blood appointments, health and well-being coach.

Covid vaccinations: We are now coming to the end of our vaccination programme and alongside the vaccination hubs have successfully vaccinated over 73% of our patients.
