

PPG Cancer care presentation

- In order to give our patients with cancer a high level of care the surgery has a cancer register and follows up every patient having active treatment or those receiving palliative care
- All patients who receive a new diagnosis of cancer receive a follow up with their GP offering support at least twice within the first 12 months

- The surgery continuously strives to improve care to all patients including cancer patients
- We are striving to improve early cancer diagnosis
- This includes trying to improve uptake of screening for cancer e.g bowel screening and cervical screening

- Cervical screening – 82.7% of those eligible are up to date with smears (72.2% nationally)
- Bowel screening uptake – 58% across England

- We review our cancer referrals and discuss complex cases or late diagnoses of cancer
- We would like to involve the PPG in improving early cancer detection and improving uptake for screening and would like your ideas on how we could do this
