  - SFH here
  - NUH here
  - GP practices and some community pharmacies:
    - Patients ≤25years of age can obtain emergency contraception tablets from some pharmacies free of charge in Nottingham City and County.
    - Patients >25 years of age can purchase over the counter.
    - All patients will be reviewed to determine suitability.
    - Please check the NHS website for a list of local pharmacies and services provided here.
  - SH24 second line option only as delays possible due to it being a postal service for City residents only.
