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Welcome to our Winter update. Dr Henry, Dr Lloyd and I (Tricia, Practice Manager) hope that you are all keeping well and would ask that you take a few minutes to read through our Winter update which contains lots of useful information. I'm sure it will come as no surprise that like the rest of the NHS our practice is under huge pressure at this time and we expect that this Winter will be a very challenging one. This update includes lots of information about how you can help us by taking care of yourself and accessing the appropriate services as they are needed; these include the local pharmacies who can help with minor ailments, the Urgent Care Centre who assess and treat minor injuries and a range of services that you can self refer to for specialist help e.g. physio, mental health. This will ensure that appointments are available in practice for those who need them most. Our reception team will always ask for a brief reason for your appointment and this will enable them to book you in with the most appropriate team member. We have a variety of clinicians in practice now which means that you may not always need to see Dr Henry, Dr Lloyd or Dr Simm. Please be assured that our reception team treat all information in confidence and we only need a brief reason to offer you the right appointment.

At the start of the pandemic we introduced telephone consultations and these have been welcomed by many patients and allow us to continue to reduce the footfall in to the practice; the virus is still circulating so we will continue to take steps to prevents its spread in our practice and to keep our patients and staff safe. If you need a face to face appointment then this will be arranged, many of our clinical team are now 100% face to face appointments including pre-bookable ones up to 4-6 weeks in advance.

We are delighted to be working with our partner practices in Bestwood & Sherwood to deliver COVID Vaccines locally so if you haven't already booked or had your booster and your 2nd dose was more than 6 months ago then don't forget to book an appointment to give you the best protection this winter.

We would like to thank all our patients for your support this year and wish you a Happy Christmas. Stay safe, keep well and remember the COVID virus is still circulating so use the Lateral Flow tests twice weekly, take a PCR test if you have symptoms, make sure to get your vaccination and wear a mask when it is recommended – including when you come in to the practice.

COVID Boosters

You are eligible for your COVID booster 6 months after your 2nd vaccination. Clinics are being held every Saturday at Hucknall Road Medical Centre (HMRC) and are by appointment only.
