It's hard to believe as we are sitting here in this sweltering heat that we are looking forward to the Autumn/Winter and are in the early stages of planning our Flu and COVID Booster clinics. You may have seen announced in the news last week that both of these will again be offered to 'healthy' 50-64 years olds. This is a change to the original plan for this year so we will be looking at how this will work and it is likely that we will be delivering these vaccinations in December. Patients who are routinely offered flu vaccinations will be able to attend our earlier clinics on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> September – these are available to book now. The COVID booster clinics will again run from Hucknall Road practice, the new vaccination centre at Haydn Road and community pharmacies.

Sadly over the past few months we have seen an increase in patients behaving in an abusive manner towards our staff. We appreciate that patients can become frustrated but any verbal, or physical abuse, directed towards our team will not be tolerated and patients will receive a warning letter and/or the police will be called. This is something we would only do in the most extreme cases but the safety of our team is essential.

One issue which unfortunately is causing patients to take their anger out on staff is being asked to wear face masks in practice. We completely understand that many patients would prefer not to wear a mask, this is the same for many of our staff, however, we have a duty of care to all patients and staff and will continue to ensure face masks are worn whilst in practice (except for those with a confirmed medical exemption) until it is safe to stop. With the current infection rates as they are this is unlikely to be anytime soon but we will continue to review in line with national guidance.

We hope you enjoy the amazing weather, stay safe and drink lots of cold drinks (non-alcoholic!).

# **NHS App**

The NHS App is a simple and secure way to

access a range of NHS services on your smartphone or tablet. You can use the NHS App



to check your symptoms and get instant advice, book appointments, order repeat prescriptions, view your GP medical record and more.

All GP practices in England are connected to the NHS App. This means that anyone aged 13 or over and registered with a GP practice in England can use it.

Download it to your smartphone or tablet and set your own security details

You can get a covid pass using the NHS App if you are 13 or over

#### **COVID PASS and Children under 13**

You can get an NHS COVID Pass online <a href="here">here</a> if you're aged 12 or over. You can also get an NHS COVID Pass in other formats using the Get your NHS COVID Pass letter service here

#### COVID PASS and Children aged 5—11

You can use the Get your NHS COVID Pass letter service for a child aged 5 or over by clicking <a href="here">here</a>. You must be the child's parent or guardian to request this letter.

On an ongoing basis we are identifying a large numbers of patients registered with us who live outside of our catchment area so if you are contacted and highlighted as being out of our area then we will have to ask you to register with a more local practice.

#### **Travel Vaccines**

Please complete the online questionnaire and submit it to us 6-8 weeks before you travel. This allows us to



ensure the form is assessed, the vaccines ordered and an appointment made. Please note, we only offer hepatitis A and typhoid

vaccinations. Any other vaccines required will need to be sourced privately.
