Covid Guidance Changes From July 19th the Government is no longer making it mandatory for the public to wear face masks or social distance. However, guidance for healthcare settings remains unchanged. As a Practice we have a responsibility to protect our team and our patients from being at increased risk from covid. To ensure we remain well and able to provide a GP service to those most vulnerable patients in need we ask that you respect our request to continue to wear a face mask on the premises if invited to see a clinician for an appointment in person. We will continue to offer a range of appointments in order to best meet the patients' needs.

General Practice Data for Planning and Research (GPDPR) From September 2021 all GP surgeries, will legally have to allow sharing of patient identifiable data with NHS digital for health and social care planning and research purposes. We are **not** allowed by law to refuse to share the information. NHS Digital will also collect information from other healthcare providers, and will be able to publish and share this data. NHS Digital hope to use this data to help NHS planning of local services and to share with research organisations.
