We would like to reassure you that we will do our utmost to ensure a smooth transition of services for our patients.

Brampton Reconfiguration.

We are in the process of converting an admin office into a consulting room to enable us to accommodate an additional GP at Brampton Surgery. Please bear with us as we make the modifications necessary to increase capacity at Brampton to meet patient demand.

Team Changes; At the beginning of February we were joined by GP trainee Dr Singh who will be with the Practice for at least 12 months. February and March are also busy months with us hosting medical students from Cambridge University.
