



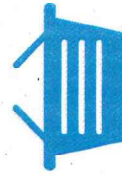

We can help with tasks such as:

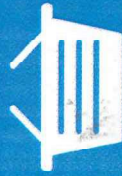
- Collecting shopping - see overleaf
