Community clinic*

Pregnancy

- Pertussis ('whooping cough' you can have this >16 weeks pregnant)
- · Respiratory syncytial virus ('RSV' you can have this >28 weeks pregnant)
- Flu (at any stage of your pregnancy, throughout 'flu season' which usually runs September -March).



Antenatal Clinic

Newborn (up to 4 weeks)



- Hepatitis B (given to baby after birth in hospital + 4 weeks old in a community clinic*, if mum is Hep B positive)
- BCG* (given to baby at 4 weeks old if they are at higher risk of tuberculosis, BCG is currently offered to those <16 years).



- Diphtheria / Tetanus / Pertussis / Polio / Hib / Hep B (given at 8, 12 & 16 weeks)
- Meningitis B (given at 8 & 16 weeks)
- Rotavirus (given at 8 & 12 weeks)
- Pneumococcal (given at 12 weeks).



Pre-school (1 - 5 years)



- Hib and Meningitis C (given at 12-13 months)
- Pneumococcal (given at 12-13 months)
- Measles / Mumps / Rubella (MMR given at 12-13 months and again at 3 years, 4 months)
- Meningitis B (given at 12-13 months)
- Flu (nasal spray given to 2 & 3 year olds and those 'at-risk' during 'flu season')
- Diphtheria / Tetanus / Pertussis / Polio (given at 3 years, 4 months).

Primary-aged child (6 - 11 years)

 Flu (nasal spray - offered every year during 'flu season').



Adolescent (12 - 17 years)

- HPV (protecting against certain types of cancers - given at 12-13 years)
- **Tetanus / Diphtheria / Polio (given at 14 years)**
- MenACWY (given at 14 years).

Adult (18 - 64 years)

- If you have certain medical conditions, you can have immunisations to better protect you, such as: flu, COVID, pneumococcal, MenB, MenACWY, **Hep A or Hep B immunisations.**
- · Please speak with your GP to see which immunisations you are eligible for.



Older adults (65+ years)



- Pneumococcal (given at 65+ years)
- Flu (given at 65+ years yearly during 'flu season')
- Shingles (given at 65 or 70-79 years, or at 50+ years) if you have certain medical conditions)
- Respiratory syncytial virus (given at 75-79 years).

Please check your / your child's eligibility for COVID-19 immunisation with your GP practice.
