Both surgeries continue to be very busy. Requests for appointments continue to outstrip capacity. We have brought in extra resources for the winter to help with demand.



We have rolled out a new centralised call system to fix the issues with the telephone call queuing process. We have also added a voicemail to the Prescription line; so if the Prescription team cannot answer your call, you can leave a voice message and they will come back to you as soon as they can. Please only use this option for prescriptions, not appointment requests. We are confident this will help ease the pressure on the phones and mean that your call is answered more efficiently. We are also making changes to the appointment booking system and to how we run reception. Thank you again for your patience while we are trying to resolve these issues: we appreciate it's been frustrating.

We are always happy to receive feedback, but please be kind. Our staff work hard and are here to try and make things better for all. They deserve and we expect them to be treated with respect. We have seen a recent increase in rudeness and bad behaviours from patients. Whilst we recognise being unwell can cause anxiety, we will not tolerate any abuse to staff.

The surgery and phone lines will be closed between 1-2 pm each day as will Lloyds chemist in Knebworth.

Lastly, Dr Osman left Marymead on 16th December. She will be missed, and we wish her well in her retirement.
