The vaccinations necessary for your trip will depend upon the countries to be visited, how you are travelling and how long you will be staying there.

If you are registered with the practice some vaccines are free of charge under the NHS such as:

- Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B (if given with Hepatitis A combined vaccine) Typhoid, Diphtheria, Tetanus and Polio.

Travel vaccinations that are not routinely covered by the NHS include: Rabies, Yellow Fever, Meningococcal Meningitis, Tick Born Encephalitis, Japanese Encephalitis and Hepatitis B (if given alone as a single vaccine)

Medicines prescribed for Malaria and travellers diarrhoea are not provided on the NHS, however, advice can be given during your travel consultation. These medicines can be purchased at most pharmacies or online.

Supply of regular medicines when travelling for longer periods of time.

The department of Health recommends that NHS prescriptions for longer than three months **should not** be routinely given. If you are planning to be away for longer than 3 months and need regular medicines you will need to see a doctor in the country you are visiting.

Private patients only

There is an additional £10 fee when patients attend for Yellow Fever vaccination.

Travel health for leisure and business travellers.

Whether you are planning a relaxing or adventurous holiday in Europe or further afield, it is important to consider the risks involved and what measures you can take to protect yourself. The travel clinic is run by qualified nurses in travel health and they will be able to assess your health risks for your individual trip.

We offer a weekly travel clinic where your travel health risks can be assessed and initiation of any necessary courses of immunisation.

Appointments can be made in the usual way by contacting reception. You will be asked to complete Pre Travel Health Form (click here to download) which you should bring with you when you attend. During the consultation you will be asked about your destination as health risks differ between regions within countries.

Some vaccinations may take several weeks to complete so please book appointments in plenty of time.

We are not always able to accommodate last minute travellers so in this case you may be asked to contact travel clinic specialists e.g. the Royal Free Travel Clinic.

Please note: Vaccine supply has been interrupted over the last 18 months and not all vaccines are available at all times.
