

Patient Experience Survey Results 2018/2019 Millway Medical Practice



Overall 85% of you rated us good, very good or Excellent. This is slightly better that our score of 84% when we did this survey last time – thank you for your continuous appreciation and support.

There are three areas you rated us less than national average – see practitioner of choice, telephone access and see a practitioner within 48 hours. In addition to scoring you also gave comments and compliments. Most of you, around 30%, commented about lack of appointments.

Responding to these findings, we are focussing our improvement efforts to improve appointments available for you as well as finding ways to improve your telephone access.

Thank you for your compliments – some 20% of the comments were praising the services provided by the practice.

If you haven't signed up for patient access ask our reception staff. You can nominate your preferred pharmacy on line using our website www.millwaymedical.com or pop into your preferred pharmacy and ask them to set it up.
