Vaccination against Covid-19 & Flu

It is very important to be fully vaccinated against Covid-19. If you are not yet fully vaccinated or have not received an invitation to attend one of our clinics please contact us on 0208 906 6075 to book an appointment; especially if you are high risk or are severely immunosuppressed.

We are offering Covid-19 vaccines to the following groups:

- •Adults aged 18 and over
- •All children aged 12-17
- •Children aged 5 -11years (who are extremely clinically vulnerable or live in a household with someone who is immunosuppressed)

If you are eligible for a 4th dose you will need to provide proof confirming your eligibility i.e. a letter from a specialist or a text invite from Millway Medical Practice when you attend your booked appointment.

Have you had your flu vaccine? Please contact us on 0208 906 6075 you can have your flu vaccine at the same time as your covid-19 vaccine if you are aged 50 and over, have certain medical conditions, are pregnant, are front-line or an adult social care worker.

When visiting Millway Medical Practice you can park in the surrounding streets for free (please see restrictions) or use the car park next to the surgery. The car park next to the surgery is managed by Euro Car Parks who use automatic number plate recognition to time your stay by

registering your car when you arrive and leave the car park. To avoid a penalty charge please make payment by cash, credit/debit card, via phone or via the RingGo app.

If you are a BLUE BADGE holder, please show your badge to a receptionist upon arrival who will assist you in how to enter your car details into the Euro car parks system. If you receive a penalty charge notice please contact Euro Car Parks directly by visiting www.eurocarparks.com

Baby checks and postnatal appointments

Between the age of 6 to 8 weeks old your baby will be due a thorough physical examination by a GP who will examine your baby's eyes, heart, hips and -

for boys – testicles will be checked. Your baby will also have their weight, length and head circumference measured. You can also use this appointment to discuss your baby's vaccinations which are offered 8 weeks, 12 weeks, 16 weeks and 12 months old, and before your child starts school between 3 years 4 months and 5 years of age; immunisations will need to be booked separately with the nurse.

Please make sure you book your postnatal check for yourself at the same time; this appointment is to make sure you feel well and are recovering properly; you will be asked how you have been feeling emotionally and physically since the birth of your baby.

NHS Health Check

The NHS Health Check is a free health check-up for adults aged 40-74 who do not already have a preexisting health condition. It is designed to spot early signs of stroke, kidney disease, heart disease, type 2 diabetes or dementia. Please call the practice to book your appointment.

Please note that we will not contact you regarding your results if no action is needed. If you need more information Test results on how long your test results are likely to take to come back from the hospital please ask the nurse. Please remember, under no circumstances will you be given the results for any patient other than yourself. Please make sure your telephone number is up to date by clicking here.

All women and people with a cervix between the ages of 25 and 64 should have regular cervical **Cervical Screening** screening, in order to prevent cervical cancer. When you receive your invite please make sure you call 0208 959 0888 to book an appointment. We are able to offer late evening and weekend appointments which locally.

You can only book a blood test appointment if the test has been requested by a GP or if you have been **Blood test in Millway** invited by the practice for a routine blood test. We have been providing a Phlebotomy Service to our patients who are aged 16 and over since September 2021.

We would like to thank all our patients who have contributed their positive feedback about the service. We are hoping that funding will be approved to continue this popular service beyond March 2022.
