

MEDICATIONS TO BE DISPENSED AS AN EMERGENCY

ENDERLEY ROAD MEDICAL CENTRE, HARROW WEALD

The following medications are only considered to 'emergency'.

Missing doses of these medications only may affect efficacy of the medication or be significantly harmful to the patient.

Salbutamol / Ventolin reliever spray
GTN spray
Medications for an arrhythmia- B blocker/verapamil/diltiazem/amiodarone
Oral nitrates
Insulin
Adrenaline pen
Contraceptive pills 28 days supply
Oral steroids (prednisolone/dexamethasone) if on regular dose
Palliative care patient medications
Lithium/antipsychotics- olanzepine, risperidone
Methotrexate/DMARDs
Warfarin/NOAC
Parkinsons disease meds
Anti epileptics- phenytoin, sodium valproate
Specialised baby milks

If your medications are not on this list, please use the normal routes for a repeat prescription.
