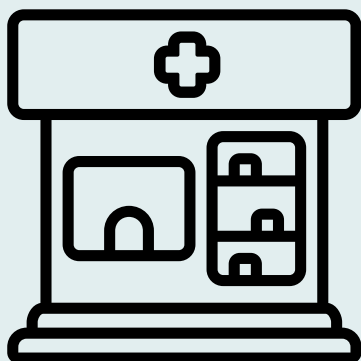


Other Services Better Equipped To Treat You



Your Local Pharmacy

GP Community Pharmacist Consultation Service (GPCPCS)

Your local pharmacist is trained to treat for minor illnesses. This includes chickenpox, bites, sprains, rashes, diarrhoea and vomiting and many more. Some people are eligible for free treatment for some conditions.

Minor Eye Conditions Service

(MECs)

Some of our local Opticians are trained and are better equipped to assess and treat minor eye conditions. This includes conjunctivitis, red eye, eye scratches, sudden change in vision.



Your Dentist

GPs are not trained to treat dental pain or infections. You need to see your own dentist.

If they cannot offer you an emergency appointment they should offer you a dental hub appointment or advise that you call to speak with the 111 dental nurse.

Please also remember that if you are waiting for an appointment in the hospital you should contact the booking line to chase your appointment.
