Matters Arising/Ongoing

- Newsletter The newsletter was published in April 2021 with very positive feedback. JD thanked Vivien and her team for their work on this. Work has started on the next one. Please forward any items to JD
- Website Nigel reported that the Medicus website can now hold PPG agendas, Minutes
 and Newsletters for Medicus PPG but not individual GP PPGs. NR said that he is sympathetic
 to the IT team as they have such a lot to do. Approximate timescales would be helpful. Dr
 Sarkar said that this is NOT acceptable, the problems need fixing. Action: NR to liaise with
 US re website problems
- Dance classes for Carers JD expressed her disappointment at the lack of response to the six week, fully funded, dance classes for carers. Only two attendees. The information was circulated to local PPGs and Enfield Carers. We look forward to being able to post events like this on the website. JD to liaise with Vivien re contacting patients to inform them of upcoming events

Medicus and Coronavirus Update

Dr Sarkar and Vivien did a slide presentation, attached

American Insurance Company buying up UK GP practices

Graham expressed his concern over this. Dr Sarkar gave his assurance that Medicus is a Partnership with no commercial value and cannot be sold.

Any Other Business

- When will injection clinics resume? these have already restarted
- When will face to face GP appointments start again? Face to face appointments ARE
 AVAILABLE. The clinician will invite patients to attend the surgery when they think it is
 necessary. The way GP practices work will never go back to pre-Covid. Patients will be
 triaged, offered a video or telephone call and asked to attend when necessary. Roger and
 Malcolm both said that they prefer the new system
- A Link Worker to help vulnerable patients Tina raised this. Vivien and Dr Sarkar explained
 that Medicus have six Social Prescribers who help vulnerable patients with their needs,
 access to food banks, loneliness, exercise etc. Clinicians refer patients to the Social
 Prescribers when they are concerned about their wellbeing
- Are Blood tests still being done at Willow Road? Malcolm raised this. Blood tests are now available at Carlton House
- Move of Bush Hill Park Surgery to Lincoln Road Clare raised this. She is concerned that
 the extra distance to travel will be too difficult for some patients, the elderly and patients
 without transport, mothers with young families. Dr Sarkar explained that general practice
 can no longer operate in converted houses. A new purpose built premises would be ideal
 but there no suitable sites available in Bush Hill Park
