- Offers of second dose have not been made yet patients will be contacted 11-12 weeks after first dose
- There is no choice of vaccine the centres get what they are given
- All the care home residents have been vaccinated
- Housebound now being vaccinated
- JD will investigate 'Cabs for Jabs' an idea to help patients unable to travel to the centres
- PPG's need to promote the vaccine in their practices
- Currently patients will be given the same vaccine for the second dose as they received for the first
- Unanimous praise for ALL the staff at the vaccination centres. Everyone has been delighted with the level of service they have received
