Telephony

Many patients reported issues with the current telephony system and we are pleased to announce that this will be changed in the New Year.

Access to GPs

Additionally, healthcare is changing rapidly and a common issue is the lack of access to GPs. The solution to the GP shortage nationwide has been to recruit specialists to work with specific issues. For example, did you know that a third of our GP requests are about musculo-skeletal issues. The GP would then have had to refer you to a physiotherapist. Under the new system our receptionist would refer you directly to a physiotherapist. If they have any concerns that the issue may be more than that they will request a GP appointment on your behalf.
