A big thank you to Martin who after 4 years has decided to stand down as Chair. The Practice and the Group thank Martin for all his hard work over the years. He will continue to attend the practice forum meetings.

Election of Chair. Plan to advertise on Notice Board for Nominations and Elect a new Chair for the next meeting in September. Nomination received from M Dadswell current chair in support of D Morrison
