List Cleansing update. This is ongoing and the message remains please let the practice know if you change your address, this goes for telephone numbers also. If you receive a letter from the Health Authority it is important that this is responded to otherwise the patient will be removed as not living there.

Letter received by patients. It is not always clear which Doctor has sent the letter, why the patient needs to be reviewed and by whom. To be discussed and actioned

Flu immunisation discussed the best way to let patients know that the flu clinics are running. Not all patients have mobiles, regular prescriptions and/or computer access. To send letters to all would not be manageable, discussed that all patients who are eligible are contacted by phone if possible.
