AFFORDABLE WARMTH

Energy support & advice

Any resident in Mid Sussex can access FREE tailor-made energy advice, available to all housing tenancies. Citizens Advice have been helping solve problems since 1939; the energy advice is provided by the Arun and Chichester advisers. They can help with checking the best energy tariffs, energy and household debts, local and national schemes, grant funding and accessing relevant community services.

Warm Home Discount

The Warm Home Discount has been increased to £150 for the winter of 2022/2023 and the eligibility criteria will be extended by almost a third and will benefit up to three million vulnerable households.

The Warmer Homes programme offers a range of energy-efficiency improvements up to £25,000 for eligible Mid Sussex residents. Available until March 2023 it includes: -insulation -solar PV panels -air source heat pumps Funding is offered on a first-come, first-served basis and applications take no longer than 5 minutes!
