### Is 'New2Diabetes' for me?

If you have been diagnosed with type 2 diabetes within the past 12 months and you live in the South East Hampshire region, then you can register for this online course.



# What is the learning format of the course?

You will receive a link to some online education videos about type 2 diabetes, which you can watch in your own time. You will then join a scheduled online group education session on Zoom. All you need is a device which allows you to access the internet, such as a smartphone, laptop or tablet.
