Fantastic News – Green Valleys Health is now an "Armed Forces Veteran Friendly Accredited GP Practice".

This means that, as part of the health commitments of the Armed Forces Covenant, we have a dedicated clinician (Dr. Watkivs) who has a specialist knowledge of military related health conditions and veteran specific health services. This is important in helping ex-forces to get the best care and treatment.

When a patient registers with our practice, they will be asked if they have ever served in the UK Armed Forces, if they have, they will be coded as "Military Veteran".

Our Summarisers (Kelly & Sarah) will then send out an automated text message advising the patient what is available to them. In summary, this is: -

Op Courage is for service leavers, reservists, veterans, and their families, who have the ability to contact the Mental Health and Wellbeing Service direct & self-refer. The patient or family member can do this by telephoning 0300 034 9986 or email-mevs.mhm@nhs.net.

The other service available is: -

Op Restore and this service is for anyone who has served at least one day in the UK Armed Forces and, as a result of their service, acquired a significant, lasting physical illness or injury. Op Restore is only available via a GP referral, which is where Dr. Watkivs' support will come in.

If you are an "Armed Forces Veteran" please let us know when you next visit the surgery so that we can ensure your medical records are updated accordingly.

Diabetic Team Summary

The Diabetic team at Green Valleys Health consists of 3 nurses, Alex Hunt, Ellie Lyons and Andrew Parry, and the Care Co-ordinators team. The nurses work across all 3 sites: Abbotswood, Leap Valley Surgery and Emersons Green Medical Centre. The team help to support patients living with a diagnosis of Diabetes, a long-term condition requiring close monitoring of blood glucose levels, blood pressure, kidney function and cholesterol management.

The team will provide a yearly review which consists of a 30-minute health care assistant check followed up a few weeks later with a 30-minute Diabetic nurse review. They may ask to see patients more frequently depending on what is discussed during the consultation. Management of diabetes includes but is not limited to, lifestyle and dietary advice, education, counselling, and medication recommendations.

The HCA will help to book the nurse follow up at this appointment, this can be booked with Alex, Ellie, or Andrew.

The 30-minute Healthcare assistant (HCA) check consists of:

- -Height
- -Weight
- -Blood Pressure
- -Blood Test
- -Foot Check-Urine Test (important for patients to bring this along to their appointment).

An early morning urine sample is required for this appointment- Please avoid alcohol, heavy exercise, and a high protein meal the night before.

The results of the health check will be reviewed and discussed along with any questions during the appointment with the Diabetic nurse.

Early prevention and intervention can prevent and/or delay the damage that Diabetes can potentially cause. The team offer personalised targets and care plans, as we know we are all on individual paths.
