The NHS App is run by the NHS. It can be accessed by anyone aged 13 and over registered with an NHS GP surgery in England or Isle of Man.

Once registered you will have easy, 24/7 access to a growing range of health services and information including:

- Access your GP health record
- Order repeat prescriptions
- Book & manage appointments
- Search symptoms, conditions and treatments.

Its easy to use, and, if you hit a snag, you can go to the 'Help' in the top right hand corner of the app or visit <u>https://nhs.uk/helpmeapp</u>.

Registration can be completed from the comfort of your own home at any time via the App. Alternatively, please ask at reception for your login details.






