

Case Study

Vaccination and immunisation training

What we did

Leeds GP Confederation has newly trained 30 non-clinical staff to administer Covid and Flu vaccinations. This training cohort represented 14 practices across 9 PCNs and will boost the skills and capacity to deliver vaccines and immunisations in their clinics. The course training was delivered by Julie Beer, Clinical Service Manager/ANP, and helped participants increase their understanding and take away practical skills to support patients. Delegates used a practical training arm to learn how to safely administer an IM vaccine and correctly dispose of needles. Following the training session, they will complete a sign off booklet with the clinical supervisor in their own practice or clinic to confirm their competency. A nominal fee was applied to attend the training and by choosing Leeds GP Confederation as the course provider, all surplus funds will be reinvested into general practice in Leeds.
