- The current service is under development. A confirmed model will be clearer in the next few months, this may possibly include a support element for young people.

Universal Stop Smoking Service

Offer:

- An initial consultation with a trained stop smoking advisor
- Weekly telephone support meetings
- Follow up 4 weeks after the designated quit date
- Practical advice about goal setting, selfmonitoring and managing barriers to quitting
- Advice and guidance on how to access appropriate nicotine replacement products
- Distribution of swap to stop vouchers for service users who wish to use vapes to help them to stop smoking.
- Signpost/refer into relevant Healthy
 Worcestershire sessions to provide
 ongoing support for the longer-term
 maintenance of successful quit attempts.
- Signpost to other stop smoking services available in Worcestershire such as Smoke Free Homes and SIP
