Covid Vaccination Program

If you are over 75 years old you are now eligible to book a 4th dose of a COVID vaccination. If you want to book a COVID Vaccination please look at the National Booking system online or call 119. You must be 6 months post your 3rd vaccination.

Any housebound and care home residents will be done by the surgery. Please note we can only vaccinate the housebound member(s) of the household. Eligibility is from 6 months of 3rd dose.

5-11 year olds will be included in the next rollout. As soon as the programme begins clinics will be available through the National Booking system online or call 119.

Repeat Prescriptions

Please allow **48 hours** for your repeat prescription to be ready. It needs to be dropped off before 2pm (Mon-Fri) to guarantee the 48 hour turn around.

Dispensary is closed Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays.

Surgery Closure

Kingsland, Leintwardine and Orleton Surgeries and Dispensaries will be **closed** from 12pm on Wednesday 18 May and reopen Thursday 19 May 22.
