You may not always need antibiotics

Antibiotics are used to treat or prevent some types of bacterial infection. They kill bacteria or prevent them from reproducing and spreading.

Antibiotics **aren't effective** against viral infections. This includes the common cold, flu, most coughs and sore throats


Appointment Access

In addition to the practice's normal opening hours you can also book an appointment in the evenings and weekends. This will be with Taurus Healthcare and may be with a different GP or nurse than you are used to. Clinics are held in Hereford, Leominster Kington and Weobley.

These appointments are all pre-bookable by contacting the surgery during our opening times – please ask for an extended access appointment.

Herefordshire Remote Health (HRH)

To help support the demand on appointments in the surgery, we have been allocated a number of telephone appointments per day with specific criteria to refer to. The Reception may suggest that they navigate you to those appointments. You do not have to do anything we will book you in with a clinician and they will call you on the number you leave. During the consultation you may be asked to bring in a sample to the surgery, you may be prescribed medication to collect from your normal Pharmacy/Dispensary, or they may feel you need a face to face appointment and ask you to book in with a GP here at the surgery.

Please allow **72 hours** for your repeat prescription to be ready (does not include weekends and Bank holidays) It needs to be dropped off before 2pm (Mon-Fri) to guarantee the 72 hour turn around.

Dispensary is **closed** Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays.
