3	Latest News and developments, incl Staffing, volume of work etc.	Dr Pruce is now GP Partner Site Lead with Dr Williams stepping down 1.9.22. Currently recruiting for new practice administrator as existing staff member, who has been in post for 46 years, is leaving at the end of October. Dr Robinson is on maternity leave and has given birth to a little girl, Dr Harrison is due to go on maternity leave in December 2023. Currently recruiting another Full Time receptionist and have appointed an additional dual role staff member who will cover both admin & reception
	Church St Surgery services through the years.	Kathleen reported on comments in the media about services that GPs are to provide. She commented, and all members agreed, that she felt that CSS had offered these services for many years.
	Requests for feedback from patients	Discussion regarding the Friends and Family Test (FFT) messages that are sent via text to patients (basically an exit poll) – these are a contractual requirement and have to be

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done. The data is collated at the end of each calendar month and discussed at the Quality & Performance (Q&P) meeting and also at WFHP Board.

National GP survey is undertaken in January each year and questionnaires are sent by post by NHS England, return is always very low. Recent survey results published are very positive for CSS – we will be doing an action plan based on the results.
