IT is NEVER too late to have the 2 doses of the vaccine, and if you think you may have missed a dose (or two) please let us know and we can check and if necessary, start the course. The first vaccine confers 90% protection. With the second, this increases to 99%

This was inspired by the Kingstone Charitable Trust kindly buying us some new children's picture books (wipe-cleanable ones) for the waiting room.
