Audiology self-referrals

If you have noticed that your hearing isn't as good as it should be then you could make a 'self referral' to an audiology specialist. Instead of visiting your GP, you can contact one of the hearing providers by clicking on this <u>link</u> to get useful advice for your hearing and what to do next.

If you are over 50 years old, they may be able to offer you an appointment and ongoing care. This includes a full clinical assessment, an NHS funded hearing aid fitting when appropriate, and after care as well.
