3	JL gave a Practice update:- Doctor Bailey has retired but still working as a locum at the moment. Vaccinations are down to the 45+ for first jabs and obviously continuation of second jabs. A new clinic at Blurton has opened to accommodate second jabs for those that can get there. Reception is facing a big spike in calls some of which are abusive and some that are not necessary. This is a nationwide problem at		

	the moment. LB informed the meeting of some of the problems that were occurring. JL also said that complaints have increased, which again takes her time and diverts her attention from her other work. 4	PP reported back on the last Locality Meeting:- Simon Whitehouse Chief Executive Integrated Care System Staffordshire & Stoke-on-Trent gave a presentation. Two new Clinicians i.e. two Ocupational Therapists and a Dietician were introduced and gave presentations. A report on the PCN Board meeting was given. There was an update on the Vaccination Programme. In a discussion on the planned NHS Reorganisation it was decided to set up a working party to look into protecting the Patient Voice in the new organisation.(AH is our rep on the group) Individual Practices reported to the meeting about their own PPGs. 5	There was discussion about the access to biddulphdoctors during the covid crisis:- As previously stated there is a big spike in demand at the moment and JL informed the meeting that the practice was looking for ways to address this including employing extra Locums. The practice has very little control over the telephone system. It was suggested that it would be better to be placed in a continuous cue i.e. you are number 12 in the cue rather than being in batches of ten then having to keep redialling. Would it be possible to have set times for phoning about specific issues. 11.00am test results, 12.00 covid questions etc. There was confusion between patients of the two Practices because of slightly different work practises and in some cases because some Patients didn't realise there are two Doctors Practices in Biddulph!
