- ✓ Children under 5 years of age
- ✓ Mobility issues
- ✓ Medical oxygen dependent
- ✓ Long term health condition

- ✓ Substance misuse
- ✓ Hoarding in the home
- ✓ Lives alone
- ✓ Previous fall

Warwickshire Fire and Rescue Service offer a free Safe and Well check to residents across Warwickshire. They are carried out by firefighters and Community Fire Safety Officers and have helped protect thousands of residents across Warwickshire from the risk of fire in their home.



The visit aims to assess the risk of fire in the home and how to minimise fire risks. A copy of our Fire Safety in the Home leaflet will also be given as part of the Safe and Well check which contains lots of useful information about keeping safe.

Smoke alarms and additional fire safety equipment can be fitted free of charge

Additional information will be given in relation to health and well-being including slips, trips and falls, smoking, electrical safety, scam callers and advice on how to improve your health and well-being.

Referrals can be made to other agencies as required to offer further support if needed.
