Dear Patient

It gives us great pleasure to announce that our new building to replace Newtown Health Centre is finally ready! We hope to move to the new location on the **25th of January 2021**. It has been a long journey and we are grateful for your patience with this, but I am sure you will agree that the new building was well worth the wait.

Our new building, **Newtown Medical Centre**, is located at, **243 Wheeler Street**, **Birmingham B19 2ET**. The new Newtown Medical Centre is 0.2 miles from our current location in Melbourne Avenue and 0.4 miles from Aston Pride Community Health Centre.

As a patient of our practice, you will be aware of our plans of the development of a new building and would have been involved in the patient consultation which was undertaken in 2016. This whole process has taken many years involving many different agencies and receiving tremendous support from our patients.

You will have noticed that in response to the Covid 19 pandemic we have had to provide our services to you differently and again thank you for bearing with us on this. It was a steep learning curve for both you and us. However, I hope you agree that there have been benefits to this new way of working, using telephone and video facilities for the purposes of consultation but also seeing patients face to face where appropriate.

As you will know, Aston Pride Community Health Centre was repurposed as a Covid assessment site for the West Birmingham area, later for other communities across the wider Birmingham area. This came at a critical time and enabled our Clinical Commissioning Group to cater for the needs of our population in a safe manner.

As the pandemic has continued, we have had to adapt the way we work with around half of our workforce working from the surgery and the other half from home. This has helped us to maintain an uninterrupted service throughout the last nine months or so. In view of these changes our Aston Pride patients have become used to receiving their primary care from Newtown Health Centre and we are hoping that they will continue to do so and get the service that they are used to from our familiar and friendly team.

As a result of our new building and the use of Aston Pride as a Covid assessment site, we have reviewed our use of space and feel that the area that we used to occupy at Aston Pride is no longer needed by the practice, so we are applying to Sandwell and West Birmingham CCG to terminate our occupation at Aston Pride from the 1st of April 2021.

As part of this process, we will be holding a listening exercise from Monday 18th January 2021 to Friday 5th February 2021 to give patients and stakeholders the opportunity to have their say on our proposals and you can do this in several ways as listed below:
