The Practice also employs a Nurse Practitioner who is able to prescribe a range of drugs for patients and holds daily surgeries in unison with the on-call GP. The Practice has a team of practice nurses, a health care assistant and medicine management team.

Godiva Group Practice has four sites, main site (Clay Lane) situated in a modern building close to the town centre of Coventry and Coventry City University Campus. Other three sites are also within two miles radius of main sites.

The Practice has a General Medical Services contract with the local health organisation Coventry & Rugby Commissioning Group and offers directly and locally enhanced services to its patients. Godiva Group Practice is also a member of Coventry GP 1 Navigation who offers wide range of services and extended hours. Godiva Group Practice has become a lead PCN (Primary Care Network) practice since 2020.

The registered activities and service types have been agreed by the Godiva Group Practice and its Registered Manager, the Partners and the Practice Manager in accordance with CQC guidance. Services are described under registered activity and Service Type.

The regulated activities under CQC are:

Surgical Procedures

- Maternity & midwifery services
- Treatment of disease, disorder or injury
- Diagnostic & Screening Procedures

The regulated services provided by Godiva Group Practice

- Routine medical checks and general/personal medical services
- NHS relevant prescriptions and medications or a private prescription can be issued.
- GP Consultation & Treatment Services will be available to all registered patients.
- Immunisations, e.g. Childhood Immunisations, Influenza, Pneumonia, and Shingles, Foreign travel advice and immunisation
- Weight loss and Dietician clinic lifestyle management We have a weight reduction clinic which is run to offer help, support and advice to patients who want to lose weight and maintain a healthier lifestyle.
- **Smoking Cessation** Any patient who is a smoker and ready to stop smoking will be referred to stop smoking clinic.
- Asthma/Respiratory clinic The Surgery has facilities for and spirometry / lung function testing.
- Diabetic clinic The Surgery operates a diabetes clinic regularly to provide ongoing care for our diabetic patients and run by trained nurses and supervised by GP Partners.
- Ear syringing Practice has facilities for ear syringing for our patients.
- **Pneumonia/Flu vaccination** At Godiva Group Practice we offer 'at risk' groups the flu vaccine at a certain time each year to protect you against the flu virus. The Practice also offers pneumonia and flu vaccine to patients aged 65 and over.
- **Social Prescribing** Do you have social, emotional or practical concerns and need support? Our Social Prescribing team can help. Know that your GP practice is more than your GP.
- Health Checks Practice offers health checks to patients aged 40 and over.
- Midwifery The community midwives hold their own clinics at for patients at our practices. They supervise antenatal care, undertake deliveries in hospital and at home where appropriate.
- Minor Surgery We offer a number of minor surgeries & joint injections. The minor surgeries are held by Dr P Bahalkar.
- **Cervical Screening** At our practices, our nurses are qualified to carry out cervical screening and tests in the form of cervical smears.
- **First Contact Physiotherapist** If you had recently hurt your muscles or you are experiencing certain bone pains, you can now see our First Contact Physiotherapist (FCP).
- Multi-disciplinary Team meeting The Surgery holds regular team meetings with other service providers reviewing palliative care and safeguarding issues.

Non NHS-Services

We also provide services which are non-NHS and are paid for by the patient. These services include:

- Insurance claim forms
- Non NHS vaccinations (limited)

- Private sick notes
- Pre-employment and HGV medical

Our practice ethos is to strive towards a partnership between patients and health professionals based on the following key facets:

Mutual Respect

At Godiva Group of Practice's, we aim and endeavour to treat all our patients with dignity, respect and honesty and would expect patients to treat all staff in the same manner.

Comments or suggestions

We welcome feedback from our patients on any issues or concerns about the service we provide. Patients should speak to Site manager or practice manager Saddam Hussain, if they would like to make any comments or observations, or if they do not understand how any aspect of the Practice operates. In this way, we can explain any misunderstandings and try to make improvements.

'Holistic' Care

We treat 'patients' and illnesses. This means that we are equally interested in the physical, psychological and social aspects of your individual care.

Continuity of Care and the 'Therapeutic relationship'

Building and maintaining a strong relationship between doctors, health professionals, and patients is essential to the way we work. This is especially so in the management of ongoing problems or long-term illness. In these circumstances we would encourage you to continue seeing the same health professional and wherever possible we will facilitate this through our appointments system. However, if you have a new problem, the doctor or nurse that you normally see is not available, or you would like to see someone else then we would encourage you to see any of the doctors or nurses at the practice.

Learning and Training

We believe in "life-long learning" and all the health professionals here and administrative staff, undergo an annual appraisal where learning and development needs are identified. We also recognise the benefit of supported learning for our patients and families in enhancing your ability to manage and deal with both 'self-limiting' and long-term illnesses

For continued patient safety and 'good practice', Significant Event Reviews (SER's) are routinely completed which are then discussed at Practice Staff and Clinical Staff Meetings. This provides an excellent opportunity for discussion of both adverse and favourable occurrences, learning, re-assessment of local procedures/guidelines and 'actions' for the future.

Open List
